Spread over 2.5 acres, the project aims to clean the Budha Nullah by processing 300 tonnes of cattle dung into five tonnes of biogas and bio-fertiliser daily.

Once operational, it will generate waste-to-wealth revenue opportunities for over 400 local dairy owners.

"This project will give a boost to green investment. This is not merely a gas plant; it is a testimony to our commitment to making Punjab greener and economically stronger," the CM said on the occasion.

He promised that more such plants would come up across Punjab to promote green energy and curb pollution levels. "I urge people not to release untreated water into water bodies so that their purity can be maintained for the well-being of every human being," he added.

The CM also highlighted prudent spending by his government.

"The money collected through taxes from the public is being judiciously spent on their welfare. People's money is flowing back to them through schools, hospitals and roads," he added.

The Chief Minister also referred to former Local Bodies Minister Sanjeev Arora, crediting him with efforts to bring the project to fruition. He said it was Arora's dream to come up with a facility for local dairy owners. "Today we have representatives from Arora's family here and in a few days, he will be out of jail. I am going to meet him soon," said the CM.

200 farmers detained outside Speaker's house

In a swift action, the police on Friday removed protesting farmers from outside the residence of Punjab Vidhan Sabha Speaker Kulraj Singh Sandhwan at his native village here. The police detained nearly 200 protesters, who were shifted to police stations across the district.

According to officials, the action followed inputs that the

protesters were planning to block national highways and railway tracks in the region. A heavy police contingent reached the protest site, clearing tents and barricades that agitators had erected there.

Security around the Speaker's residence was subsequently strengthened, with multi-layered checkpoints set up along the main access roads. Farmer leader Kaka Singh Kotra condemned the police action, terming it

"undemocratic". The police released the protesters, belonging to the BKKU (Ekta-Sidhupur), around 8.45 pm.

The release came following a verbal agreement with union representatives. According to sources, farmers agreed to clear the blocked Bathinda-Ferozepur railway line. Farmers resumed their sit-in protest in front of the Punjab Agricultural Development (PAD) Bank on the main Kotkapura-Faridkot road, a site that had been

cleared earlier by the police. Union general secretary Kaka Singh Kotra confirmed the development. The farmers have been protesting at the spot for the past 10 days, seeking compensation from the state government for losses suffered during the agitation at the Shambhu and Khanauri borders, the return of blank cheques collected by the land mortgage banks from indebted farmers and a complete waiver of farmers' loans.
